



Snack Bar Duty & Field Duty Agreement

Each parent or guardian is required to submit a deposit of \$50 per child for snack bar & field duty. (Check made out to GFSO or Cash Accepted). Each parent is required to work one 3 hour shift per child registered during the rec season. All deposits will be returned or refunded within 2 weeks of fulfilling your scheduled shift(s). All cash deposits will be refunded via check from GFSO. Parents have the option to "opt out" of snack bar & field duty. The "opt out" fee will be \$30.00 per child registered and will only be available at the time of registration.

Information on Snack & Field Duties:

- I. At the beginning of the season you will receive an online link or sign-up sheet to sign up for a shift that accommodates your schedule. Each shift will be for 3 hours. It will be your responsibility to sign up before Opening Day. After this date you will be assigned a date that cannot be changed. There will be no make-up days or schedule changes. You are responsible to work the shift you sign up for or are assigned, if you cannot make the assigned shift, you may have a responsible adult 16 years of age or older work it for you. If you fail to appear or you do not have an adult work your shift, your deposit and/or cash will be forfeited.
- II. During your shift, the board member on duty will show you the procedures as well as show you where to sign in. *YOU MUST SIGN THE SIGN-IN SHEET AND FILL IN THE REPRESENTED PLAYER'S NAME FOR THE LEAGUE TO RECOGNIZE THAT YOU HAVE WORKED OR YOUR CHECK WILL BE CASHED.* You must work the entire shift. Don't be late or leave early, please plan on arriving 10 minutes prior to your scheduled time to allow for training, also plan to stay the entire shift, if you leave early this will result in your name being removed from the list and you will lose your deposit.
- III. Snack bar duties include but are not limited to food prep, washing dishes, working the window, cooking on the BBQ, working the register and light cleaning. Field duty will include but is not limited to preparing the fields before and after games, assist with trash & recycling, checking the restrooms, walking the fields and parking lot to help maintain safety.
- IV. After the snack bar & field duty sign in sheets are reviewed, those who have worked their entire shift will have their deposits returned. Deposits will be available for pick up on Saturday following your shift from 9-12. If you cannot pick up your check during this time you may give a self-addressed envelope to the snack bar director and they will mail your deposit to you.
